General Care Tips

Daily Care: Vacuum fabric upholstery regularly using an upholstery attachment to remove dust, dirt and allergens. This is particularly important for high-use areas like seat cushions and armrests.

Spot Cleaning: For minor spills or stains, blot the area immediately with a clean, dry cloth to absorb as much liquid as possible. Then, use a mild solution of water and mild soap to gently clean the stain. Always blot—never rub—to avoid spreading the stain or damaging the fibers.

What to Avoid

Excessive Water: Avoid soaking the fabric, as too much moisture can lead to mold, mildew and damage to the upholstery padding.

Bleach and Harsh Chemicals: Do not use bleach or harsh chemical cleaners, as these can weaken fabric fibers, cause fading or create permanent discoloration.

Abrasive Materials: Never use steel wool, scouring pads or any abrasive materials on upholstered surfaces, as they can cause permanent damage.
