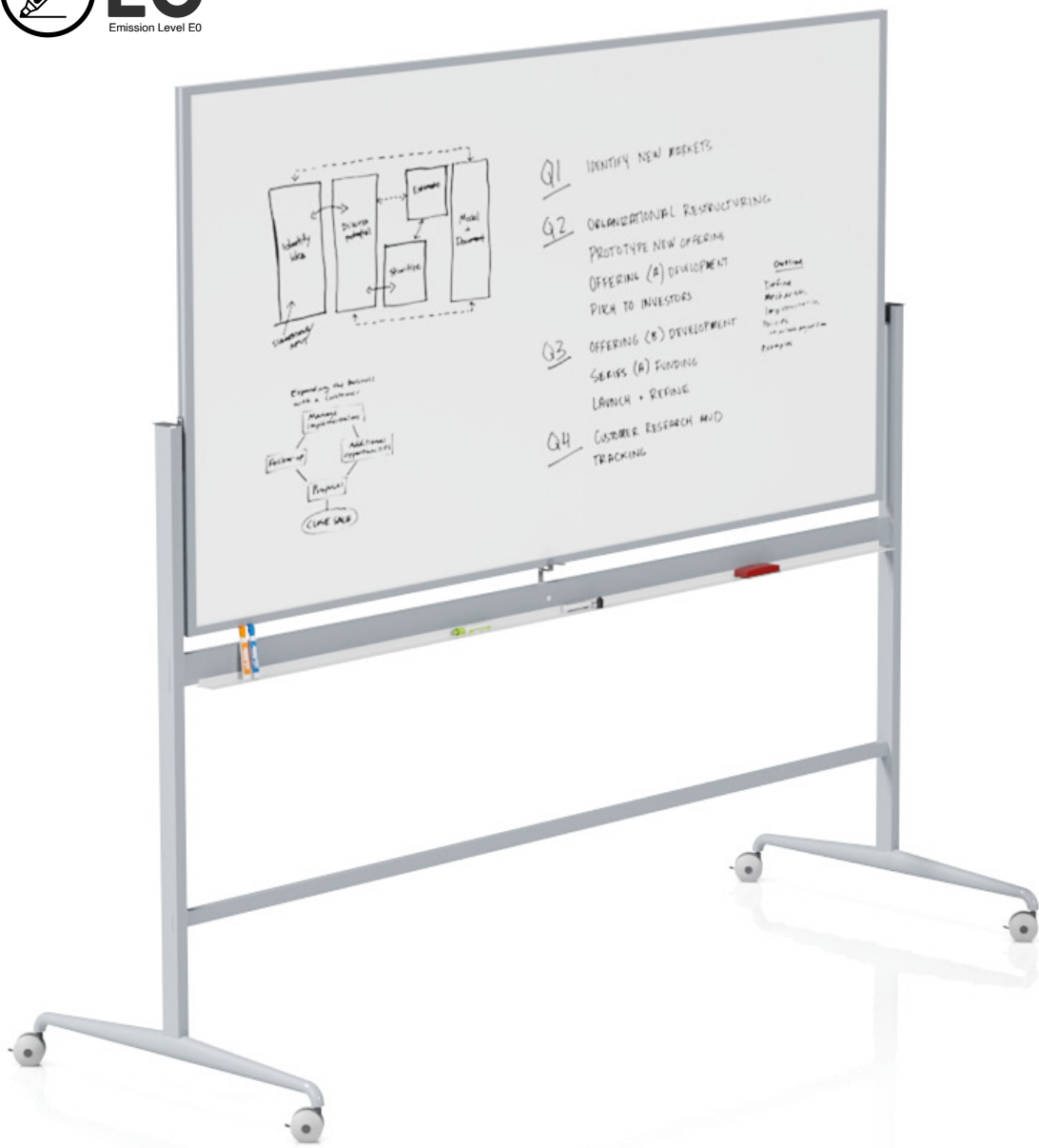


Mobile Whiteboard

Cleaning Guide

General Care Tips

Daily Care: Use a soft microfibre cloth or whiteboard eraser to remove marker residue and dust from the porcelain surface. For regular cleaning, wipe the board with a slightly damp cloth or use a whiteboard cleaning solution designed for porcelain whiteboards. Dry the surface afterwards with a clean cloth to maintain a streak-free finish.

Deep Cleaning: For a more thorough clean, apply a small amount of whiteboard cleaner or a mixture of warm water and mild dish soap to a soft cloth. Gently wipe the surface to remove built-up marker residue or smudges. Rinse with clean water if required and dry thoroughly with a soft cloth to prevent streaking or water marks.spots or streaks.

What to Avoid

Bleach and Harsh Chemicals: Avoid using bleach, ammonia-based cleaners, acidic products or solvent-based chemicals, as these may damage surrounding frames, trims or writing surfaces over time.

Abrasive Materials: Do not use steel wool, scouring pads, abrasive sponges or rough cleaning tools on the whiteboard surface, as these can scratch the finish and reduce erasability.

Permanent Markers: Only use dry erase whiteboard markers designed for porcelain whiteboards. Permanent or industrial markers may leave difficult-to-remove staining if left on the surface for extended periods.
