

# Pillar Curve Table

## General Care Tips

**Daily Care:** Start by dusting the laminate surface with a soft, dry cloth to remove loose dirt and dust. For routine cleaning, use a damp cloth with a mild detergent or a specifically formulated laminate cleaner. Ensure that the cloth is only slightly damp to avoid excess moisture.

**Deep Cleaning:** For a more thorough clean, mix a small amount of mild dish soap with warm water. Gently wipe the surface using a soft cloth, following the grain or pattern of the laminate. Rinse the cloth with clean water and wipe again to remove any soap residue. Dry the surface with a clean, dry cloth to prevent water spots or streaks.

## What to Avoid

**Bleach and Harsh Chemicals:** Avoid using harsh chemicals such as bleach, ammonia or acidic cleaners, as these can damage the laminate's protective layer and lead to discoloration or peeling.

**Abrasive Materials:** Never use steel wool, scouring pads, or any abrasive materials on laminate surfaces, as they can cause scratches and dull the finish.
